PATHWAYS



THEATER

Students explore the collaborative theater-making process. Classes focus on acting and performance, theater games and improvisation, theater leadership, directing, playwriting, and creating original theater. Students may use the theater program to prepare for continued college study or as a pathway toward personal enrichment and artistic expression. Theater classes are taught in a supportive environment, allowing students to gain skills and experience as creative problem solvers, improving communication and articulation skills.

MUSIC & VOCAL

The Music Pathway allows students to dive deep into the roots of American music with a focus on folk, blues, jazz, pop, and original composition. Students build music skills by participating in instrumental and vocal ensembles and targeted skills classes led by working professional artists. Students on the Music Pathway have opportunities to perform throughout the year in recitals, concerts, and community events. Students can choose between an instrumental and vocal focus or a musical theater focus.
